Farms, Promises and Half Truths

Leslie Blohm QC and Christopher Jones, Barristers, St John's Chambers

Leslie and Christopher will deliver a lecture on informal agreements and partnership assets in a farming context. The talk will look at the recent cases of *Wild v Wild [2018] EWHC 2197* and *Ham v Bell [2016] EWHC 1791* and consider what lessons can be drawn from those judgments and applied by the busy practitioner.

Partnership Disputes – An Accountant's Approach
